

GENERAL RULES

1. Acceptance of the rules and acceptance of the judge's decision as final is a condition of entry.
2. Hard Hats to be worn to PAS015 (see website for more information) with fastened harness and correct footwear to be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
3. Body protector BETA level 3 standard (2009) to be worn for ridden classes. An air jacket may be worn in addition.
4. General riding wear to be worn. It is not necessary to wear show gear to this event.
5. No responsibility for loss, damage or injury to horse/rider, rider, spectator or property will be accepted by the Organisers.
6. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, modify, reduce, amalgamate, cancel or make any alterations
7. Any objection lodged must be accompanied by £20.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
8. Entry fees can only be refunded on production of Veterinary/ Doctor's Certificate
9. No horse/pony under 4 years may be ridden on the show ground or compete under saddle.
10. No Stallions on the show ground without prior agreement with the Organizers.
11. Lungeing not permitted on show ground.
12. Horses to walk only outside of Rings in the interest of safety.
13. Any dogs on site must be kept on a short lead at all times and any excrement cleared up. No dogs to go into Arenas or beyond the car park/ spectator area. All other horse paddocks and grazing are out of bounds and are dog free zones.
14. Please keep car park tidy. Do not leave hay or droppings behind. Droppings may go on the muck heap. Please do not put trailer droppings into Arena Skips!
15. A competitor may ride a maximum of 2 horses per class.
16. Please note for some shows and Championship Shows there may be additional rules.
17. All classes judged in conjunction with Trec GB Rules & Twin Trees Riders Club Rules.
18. N.B. A horse or pony may compete in as many classes as the rider is eligible for, but can only take part once in each Individual class.
19. Hors Concours entries may be considered, at the organiser's discretion.
20. The Organisers reserve the right to consolidate or divide classes

Class 1 Intro Trec The control of paces will be ridden first. The PTV Course will consist of 10 obstacles. Horse and rider combination not to have won this class 3 times are eligible to compete. Assistance allowed but no leadrein. (Level 1)

Class 2 Improvers Trec Horse and rider combination not to have won this class 3 times are eligible to compete. (Level 1 -2)

Class 3 Open A Open to any rider, any age, on any suitable horse or pony. (Level 3 / 4)

Class 4 Open B Open to any rider, any age, on any suitable horse or pony. (Level 3 / 4)
Class 4 and 5 will have different obstacles.

Trec Guidelines:

MA (Control of paces) – The rider enters a marked corridor in as slow a canter as possible and maintains the pace and then returns along the same corridor in as fast a walk as possible. A maximum of 30 points available for canter and walk (score will be halved in line with Trec GB rules). A break in pace or a foot outside the corridor scores zero.

Cross Country Trials (PTV) –10 simulated obstacles which you might come across while out riding set up in the arena. Each obstacle is scored out of 10. All obstacles are optional. Where an obstacle is missed out the score is zero for that obstacle. The course is timed. Riders will be stopped if they run out of time.

Awards: Rosettes to 6th Place and prize to 3rd if sufficient entries.

The winner will be the highest combined total from both phases. In the event of a tie the time from the PTV is used to determine the placement.

What do we Wear? General riding gear. Hats to be to current safety standards. Body Protectors must be worn. (An air jacket may be worn in addition) See rules.

Entries to be paid no later than one week before the Competition and can only be accepted with correct payment. **Email entry form to team@twintrees.net. We will contact you to confirm place and take card payment over the phone. Alternatively bring entry to the yard before closing date.** Unfortunately, we are no longer able to take cheques.

After the closing date late entries may be accepted if time permits or classes not full at £2 extra per class.

If you intend to leave before the end of the class and wish your score sheet to be forwarded to you, please leave a SAE large letter rate with the secretary or add £1 to entry fee.
