

# Information for the Eventer Challenge

## Centre Rules:

- Lorry/ and towing vehicles only to use back lorry park. All other vehicles to use front car park.
- Please try to keep spectators to a minimum
- If you must bring a dog it must be on a short lead at all times and not go into the Arenas
- Please do not tie to gates, fences etc – horses and dogs
- Water for horses is available
- Toilets are available
- Unfortunately, there will not be drinks & hot refreshments available during the event due to catering van being unable to attend.

## What to wear:

- Body protectors must be worn. BETA Level 3 (2009) is the minimum standard.
- An air jacket if worn must be over a traditional body protector due to the solid fences being included in the course.
- Jockey Skull Cap to be worn to PAS015 (hat must not have a fixed Peak) as a minimum.
- Please check your equipment! Any rider with incorrect safety equipment will not be allowed to compete.
- Riders will need their own number: bridle or xc bib or saddlecloth.
- Rider may wear either Show Jumping attire or XC colours.

## Collecting ring reminders:

- Only horses entered to compete are welcome to attend the centre unless prior arrangement has been made. (They are not permitted to use the collecting ring.)
- If you are not warming up for your class please leave collecting ring to allow other competitors to warm up. Horses not to be stood in the arena at the end/corners.
- Having jumped please use collecting ring to warm down and then leave so the later riders have ample room to warm up.
- The fence height in the warm up arena will not be bigger than the fences currently being jumped in the main ring.

## Classes:

- The classes will involve a 7 fence simulated XC course followed immediately by a timed 7 fence SJ section. The XC jumping starts with a bell, after the last XC jump rider must take a direct line to the first SJ fence. This second section is timed. (The course is ridden as one complete round). The winner will be the horse with the lowest penalty score at the end of the competition. In the event of a tie on penalties the fastest time over the SJ section will be deemed the winner.
- There will be no ridden presentation of rosettes at the end of a class. They will be available for collection from the gate steward 10-15 minutes after the results are announced.
- No additional entries will be taken/ changed on the day.
