

GENERAL ARENA TREC RULES

1. Acceptance of the rules and acceptance of the judge's decision as final is a condition of entry.
 2. Hard Hats to be worn to PAS015 with fastened harness and correct footwear to be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
 3. General riding wear to be worn. It is not necessary to wear show gear to this event.
 4. No responsibility for loss, damage or injury to horse/rider, rider, spectator or property will be accepted by the Organisers.
 5. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, or cancel any classes without notice. Large classes may be split at the Organiser's discretion.
 6. Any objection lodged must be accompanied by £25.00 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
 7. Entry fees can only be refunded on production of Veterinary/ Doctor's Certificate minus admin fee of £2.50.
 8. Any horse not competing may not be ridden/led in the collecting ring or on the show ground.
 9. No horse/pony under 4 years may be ridden in a class or on the show ground.
 10. No Stallions on the show ground.
 11. Lungeing not permitted on show ground.
 12. Horses to walk only outside of Rings in the interest of safety.
 13. Any dogs on site must be kept on a short lead at all times and any excrement cleared up. No dogs to go into Arenas .
 14. Please keep trailer/lorry park tidy. Do not leave hay or droppings behind.
 14. A competitor may ride a maximum of 2 horses per class.
 15. All classes judged in conjunction with Trec GB Rules & Twin Trees Riders Club Rules.
 16. A horse or pony may compete up to twice in class 1 and 2 at this show with different riders subject to eligibility.
 17. Hors Concours entries may be considered, at the organiser's discretion

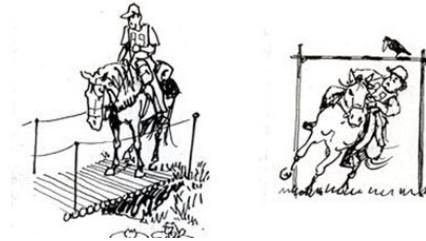

Class 1 In Hand

An opportunity for young or inexperienced horses to have a go at TREC by completing a course of 10 led obstacles. Hats must be worn and a whip is permitted (maximum length 75cm). Horses can be led in either a bridle or headcollar/halter on a short lead.

Class 2 Novice Rider/ Novice horse

The rider will complete the MA first by trotting as slowly as possible down the corridor and then walk back in the opposite direction as quickly as possible. After riders will complete the 10 obstacles.

Class 3 Intro Trec

Horse and rider combination not to have won this class 3 times are eligible to compete. The MA corridor will involve the slowest canter and fastest walk. After riders will complete the 10 obstacles. (A penalty will be given if no canter is seen in MA)

Class 4 Open Trec Open to any rider, any age, on any suitable horse or pony. MA corridor will involve the slowest canter and fastest walk. After riders will complete the 10 obstacles.

Class 5 Open Trec Open to any rider, any age, on any suitable horse or pony. MA corridor will involve the slowest canter and fastest walk. After riders will complete the 10 obstacles. This will include some local obstacles plus those found in Working Equitation.

The winner will be the highest combined total from both phases. In the event of a tie the time from the PTV obstacles is used to determine the placement.

Class 2 may have assistance in ring. Any rider/horse combination competing in Class 2 may not compete in Class 4 or 5.
